WE CAN RAMP UP THE ENGAGEMENT BY ALLOWING OUR STUDENTS TO WORK IN GROUPS AS THEY WORK ON CHALLENGING MATERIAL. PRIDE MONDAYS






STUDENTS DISCUSSING THE OUTSIDERS IN ELA


