Participation Guidelines:

Mid-Marking Period Progress Reports (MMPs):

If a student has a grade below 65 in Math, Social Studies, English, Science, French, Spanish, or Italian at the conclusion of the Mid-Marking Periods (MMP 1, MMP 2, MMP 3, and MMP 4), they will be expected to attend the ASIP program at least once per week for each core course they are failing. Sports/Extracurricular - Students are required to attend in order to participate in extracurricular activities and modified sports and games. Once the grade is passing the student no longer needs to attend.

Marking Periods (MPs):

- If a student has a grade below 65 in Math, Social Studies, English, Science, Italian, French and/or Spanish at the conclusion of Marking Periods (MP 1, MP 2, MP 3, and MP 4), they must attend the ASIP program at least once per week for each core course they are failing in order to participate in extracurricular activities. The intervention teacher will offer additional support on the classes the student has failed. If the student's grade dips below 65, they may not participate in any games. Once they complete the work to get above a 65 they can play in games again. This will also apply to participation in the school musical.
- At the next MMP point, if they are passing with a 65, they no longer need to attend; if they are still failing, they must continue to attend and will not be eligible to play games at that point until their grades are passing.
