Arrival

Doors open at 7:45am, breakfast served from 7:20am.

Classes

School begins promptly at 7:50am, dismissal at 2:20pm.

After School

Students must be with a teacher, in study hall, or in the after-school program.

Parking

- The loop closest to the building is closed and may only be used by busses during arrival and dismissal times.
- Please pull all the way into the loop that is farthest from the school (close to visitor parking spots) so busses are not blocked.
- Please do not park in the fire lane.
- Please do not park on the grass by the college parking lot.

Attendance & Tardiness

Excused Absences

Illness, religious events, medical appointments, emergencies.

Unexcused Absences

Car trouble, weather, oversleeping, family vacations.

Tardiness

Any arrival after 7:50am, disciplinary action after 5 tardies.

Sign-Out Procedures



Written Note

Provide a written note before homeroom for early dismissal.



Sign-Out

Students must sign out in the main office before leaving.



Parent Pickup

Parents must come to the office to sign students out in an emergency.

Raptor Visitor Management System.

- All visitors will be required to present a government issued identification card in order to gain access to the school.





Extracurricular Eligibility

1

Attendance

Students must be present at least half the day to participate.

2

Behavior

No OSS/ISS the month before or week of an event.

Academics

- Student must participate in the Academic Success Program until grades are above a 65 in Math, Science, Social Studies and English

Student Expectations

3 Hall Passes

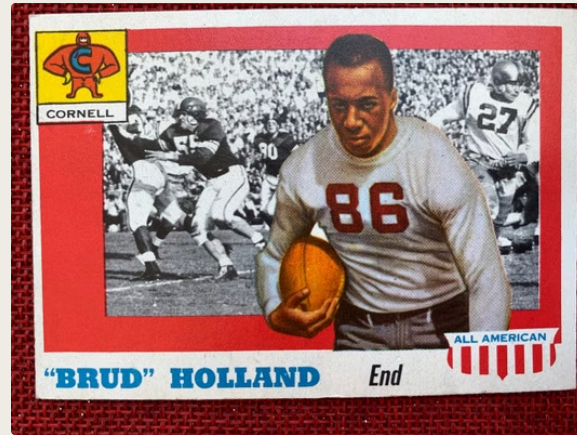
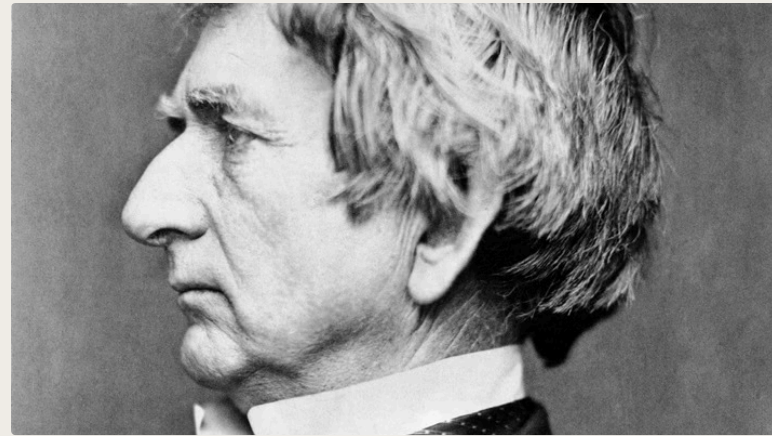
Use hall passes when leaving the classroom during class time.
