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What is P.B.I.S.?

PBIS, or positive behavior interventions & supports, includes proactive strategies for defining, teaching, and supporting appropriate student behaviors. The goal of PBIS is to create a positive school environment for all.

We have **PRIDE!**

P We *productively struggle*.

R We are *respectful*.

I We are *in control* of ourselves.

D We are *dedicated* to learning.

E We are *empathetic*.

P.B.I.S. at Genesee:

- We focus on recognizing **positive** behaviors.
