Sheriff Brian Schenck reports that on March 2, 2022 the Auburn Police Department made a request for investigative assistance related to a complaint that they had received involving one of their officers. A criminal investigation was initiated which resulted in the arrest of William T. Morrissey III (32) of Whitehead lane in the Town of Throop. Morrissey was charged with the below listed offenses related to repeated inappropriate conduct with a student occurring in and around the City of Auburn including Auburn High School where he was serving as a School Resource Officer.

Assisting in this investigation were the Auburn Police Department, Cayuga County 911, The Auburn Enlarged City School District and the Cayuga County District Attorney's Office. Morrissey was arraigned in the Centralized Arraignment Part and committed to jail in lieu of \$25,000 cash bail or \$50,000 bond.
