PROGRAM INFORMATION



What is the Auburn Summer Music Lessons program?

These are free summer instrumental lessons for any student in Cayuga County. Students can choose to take lessons in an instrument that is new to them or on an instrument they already play. Students take lessons in an individual or small group setting with a teacher who also plays their instrument.

Who is eligible?

Any student who is currently in grades 3-11 in Cayuga County is eligible to take lessons. No experience with an instrument is necessary. If a student will be eligible for taking band or orchestra next year, this is a great way to get them started.

When and where is the program?

Lessons will take place at the Hoopes Park Clubhouse on Genesee Street in Auburn. They start on Monday July 1st and run for five weeks. The end of lessons concert will take place on Friday, August 2nd.

What is the time commitment for my student?

Your student will have a half hour lesson every week for five weeks and participate in one concert. If you already have vacations or summer activities planned, we ask that you be able to commit to making sure your student is there for at least four of the weeks to ensure success. There may also be one evening rehearsal in the last week to prepare for the concert.

Are there any costs associated with lessons?

The cost of lessons is free. There is a \$20 nonrefundable registration fee. This fee covers the cost of the t-shirt that will be worn for the end of lessons concert. Students who do not have an instrument do not need to purchase one. We will work with you to borrow an instrument for the summer.

How do I sign my student up?

Registration is entirely online. Use the QR code on the right of this page and it will take you to the Google Form where you can register your student. Registration and deposits are due by Friday, June 8th.
